From I-85 heading South: Take Exit 69 Spur 14 S. Fulton Pkwy From South Fulton Prkwy, then below.*

***Below for all directions above:** Stay on S. Fulton Pkwy for 7.5 miles then Right on "Hwy 92 Campbellton Fairburn Rd". Go 4.5 miles then Left on "Hwy 70 Cascade Palmetto Rd". Go 0.3 miles then Right on "Cochran Mill Rd". Go 1/10th mile, then right onto Browns Lake Road.

From I-20 heading East: Take Exit 37 Hwy 92 Fairburn/Douglasville; end of ramp go Right on 92 South/ Fairburn Rd. Go 5.2 miles then go Right at light staying on 92 South Fairburn Rd. Go for 4.2 miles then at light go Right on Cascade Palmetto Rd. Go 0.3 miles then Right on Cochran Mill Rd. Go 1/10th mile, then right onto Browns Lake Road.

From I-85 heading North: Take Exit 61 Hwy 74, Fairburn; end of ramp go left heading North on 74. When the 4-lane lane turns into a 2-lane, stay straight (do not continue on 74; go straight for 2.3 miles until the road dead ends into Rivertown. Go left on Rivertown for 3.5 miles to S. Fulton Pkwy. Cross over S. Fulton Pkwy staying on Rivertown for 2 miles then right at 4-way stop on Cochran Mill Rd. Go 1/10th mile, then right onto Browns Lake Road.

****REFUNDS - MAWA** will issue a refund of entry fees for dogs that are in season or lame, If your hound comes in season or becomes lame before the Trial, and you will not be attending Trial for these reasons, you must call the Trial Secretary BEFORE Roll Call – otherwise you forfeit your entry fees!

General Information

- Dogs of these breeds recorded with the Purebred Alternative Listing Program/Indefinite Listing Privilege (PAL/ILP) or dogs with Conditional registration are eligible to participate.
- Spayed and neutered dogs are eligible to participate.
- Monorchid and cryptorchid dogs are ineligible to participate.
- Bitches in season are not eligible to participate.
- Hounds with breed disqualifications, as listed in the AKC Breed Standards, are ineligible to enter lure coursing trials and tests.
- Dogs with Limited Registration are eligible to participate.
- All entries must be at least one year of age the day of Trial
- Stakes will be split if 20 or more entries are present in any one stake at the time of the draw.
- Hounds not present at time of Roll Call will be scratched and entry fees will NOT be refunded.
- Battery-powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used with back-up equipment available.
- The lure will consist of light and/or light colored plastic
- Muzzles are not required: It is the responsibility of the owners to determine if the hound should be muzzled

IMPORTANT Facility Information

This trial will be held at Chattahoochee Hills Eventing. CHE is an 8,000-acre equestrian eventing estate that run 12 miles along the Chattahoochee River. Convenient to the Atlanta Airport and downtown Atlanta.

PLEASE NOTE: Horses and Riders have the Right of Way!! Drive SLOWLY. Once you have turned onto the farm you will then be directed to a narrow 1 lane gravel/dirt road. It is about 2 miles to the field. Please park in designated areas only,

Attention drivers of RVs: The road to the field is narrow and has overhanging branches. Large RV's will NOT fit! . Please call the Field Trial Chairman 770-689-7106 to inquire about parking area/directions. If you need to park away from the field a shuttle will be provided for you and your dogs. NO HOOK-UPS

AKC TEST

The JUNIOR COURSER TEST is open to all hounds of an eligible breed. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a judge on one date and a second certification from a different judge at a later date, stating that the hound completed at least a 600 yard course with a minimum of four turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

****It is recommended that Junior Courser hounds entering the open stake for the first time have successful practice experience with other hounds before competing****

Stakes Offered

AKC TRIAL STAKES

OPEN: Open to all hounds of an eligible breed that have attained at least one of the following: AKC Junior Courser Title, ASFA Field Champion Title, CKC Field Champion Title, and AKC Field Champion Title. Championship points may be awarded from this stake.

OPEN VETERAN: Open to all hounds, which are eligible to enter either Open or Special Stake, and are of Veteran age as determined by their Parent Breed Club. Championship or LCX points may be awarded from this stake.

SPECIAL: Open to all hounds that are eligible to enter the Open stake and have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. LCX points may be awarded from this stake.

Hounds under disqualification from AKC, ASFA, or CKC Field Trials may NOT be entered.

A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any loose hounds not competing in the course in progress

A return check fee of \$25.00 will be assessed for any check(s) returned for insufficient funds.

MAWA assumes no liability for injury to any person or dog before, during or after these trials.

Please bring your own shade, beverages, and water.

Fun Runs will be offered after both test and trial competitions are complete and as time of daylight permits. \$5.00 each.

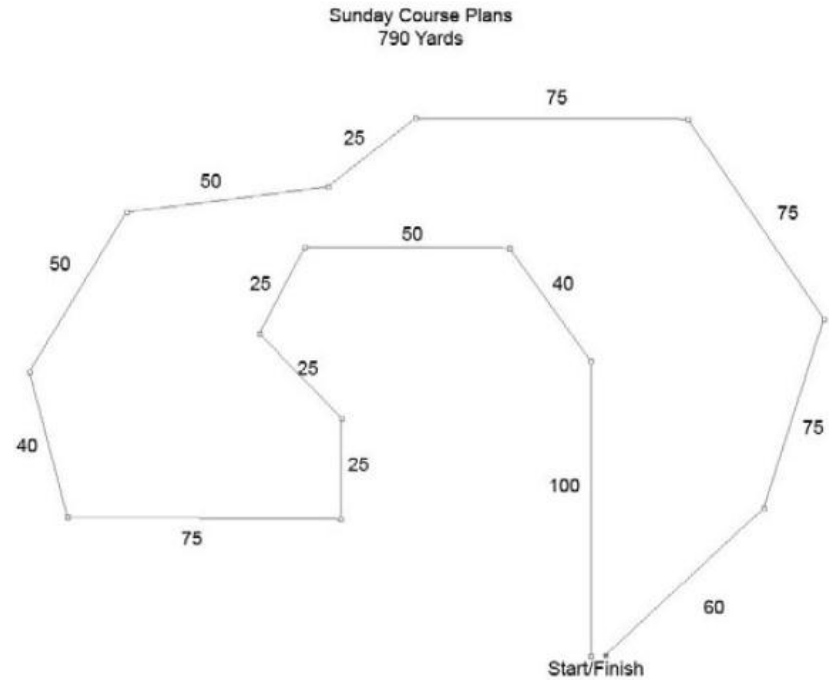
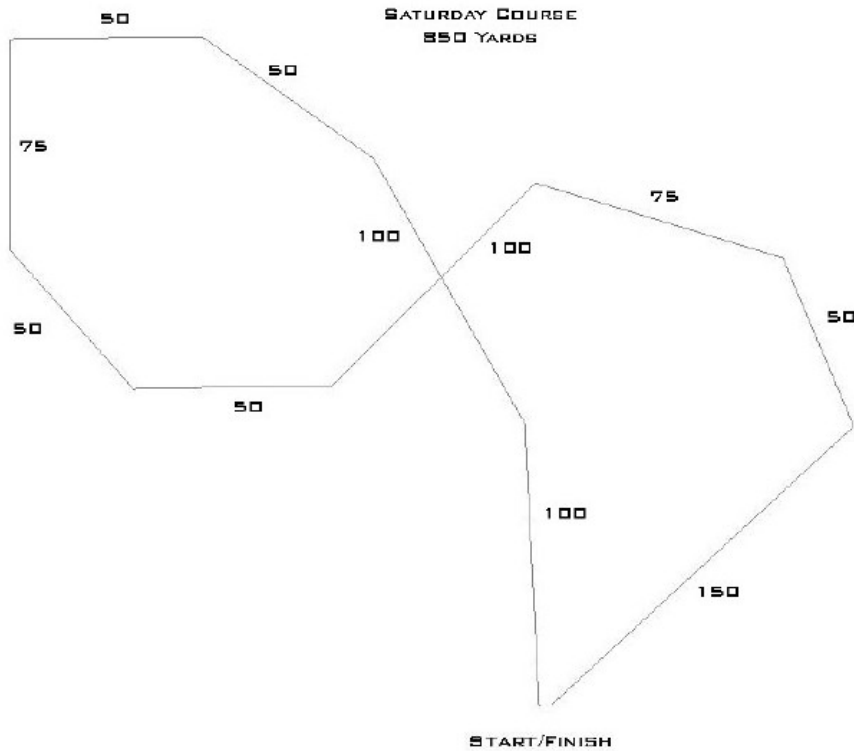
FIELD CONDITIONS

It is a hayfield and is not perfectly groomed, but it is primarily level.

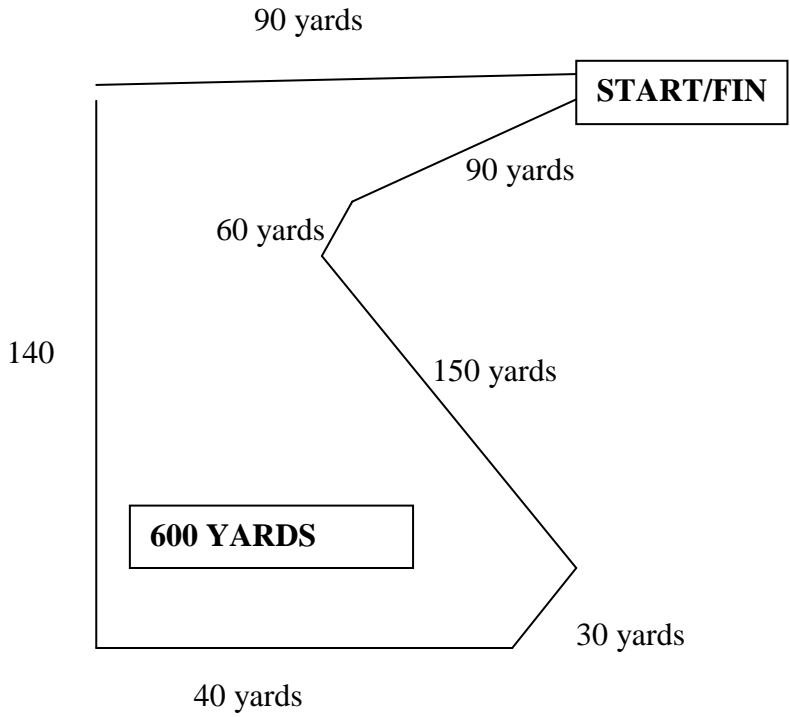
Course design is subject to change depending on weather and field conditions.

SUNDAY 790 Yards

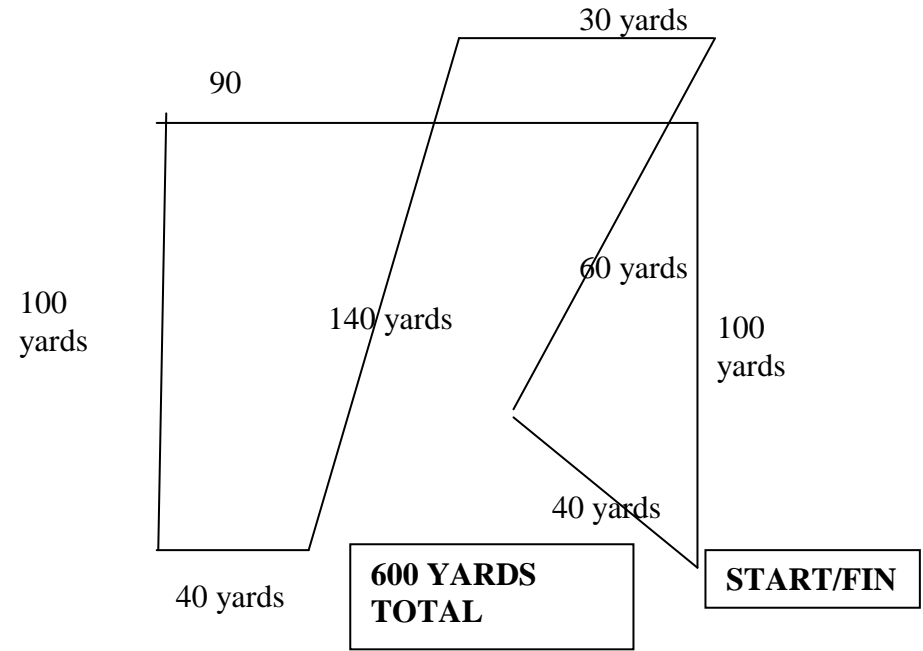
SATURDAY 850 yards
