DIRECTIONS: We will be using the Steeplechase field. The field is just off of Centennial Olympic Parkway and across the street from the Hawthorn Suites.. The field is in Rockdale County, GA, approx. 24 miles east of Atlanta. For more information, go to <http://georgiahorsepark.com> From Atlanta and the west: Take I-20 east. Exit I-20 at Exit 82 (GA-20 N/GA-138 E) toward Monroe/ Conyers. Travel north on GA-20/GA-138 approx. 4 mi. Turn right onto Centennial Olympic Parkway. The entrance to the field is 2 mi ahead on the right. Follow signs. From the east: Take I-20 west. Exit I-20 at Exit 84 (GA-162/Salem Rd). Exit right onto GA-162/Salem Road (which becomes Sigman Road) for approx.. 1.1 mi. Turn right onto Gees Mill Road for approx.. 2.5 mi. Pass Gate A. Turn right onto Centennial Olympic Parkway. Pass Gate B and the traffic light. Turn right into the main entrance to the park on the right. Follow signs to the field

Care of the Grounds

Kindly enter the field at the designated area only. Parking areas will be clearly marked. Please clean up after your hounds. This is a **NON SMOKING FACILITY!**. There will be a \$15 fine levied on all smokers leaving cigarette butts on the grounds or people caught not cleaning up after their dogs!!

There will be portable toilets available – DO NOT put poop bags in the toilet!!!

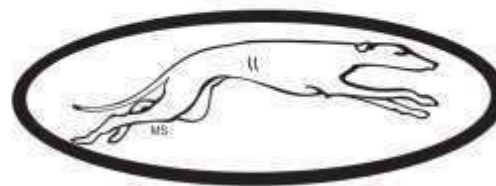
- RV and Tent Camping allowed. NO HOOK-UPS

Eligibility

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco Dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Italian Greyhounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Norrbottenspets, Peruvian Inca Orchids, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengos, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Sloughis, Scottish Deerhounds, Thai Ridgebacks, and Whippets that are one year of age or older and have been registered with The American Kennel Club or an AKC recognized foreign registry or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) OR Purebred Alternative Lists (PAL) may be entered. Breed disqualifications apply. **Note: Italian Greyhounds and Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are not eligible to compete for Best in Field.**

Junior Courser and Qualifying Courser Offered

Junior Courser (JC): Open to all eligible sighthounds. A hound running alone must receive a certification from a judge on one date, and a second certification from a different judge at a later date, with each judge stating that the hound completed a minimum 600-yard course with a minimum of 4 turns. The hound must complete the entire course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

Qualifying Courser (QC): Open to all eligible sighthounds. The qualifying hound will run with another hound, completing a (minimum) 600-yard course with a minimum of 5 turns. The qualifying hound must complete the entire course with enthusiasm, without interruption, and without coursing, interfering with, or aggressing on the other hound. Owner of qualifying dog must provide or arrange for a hound of like running style for their hound to run with in this test.

Stakes Offered

Open: Open only to hounds of eligible breed, with no breed disqualifications, that hold an AKC QC certificate OR have run in the Open Stake prior to Jan. 1, 2010, OR have a Senior Courser title OR have an ASFA or CKC field champion title. (a copy of this title must be attached to the entry form if the QC requirement is to be waived). Championship points are awarded from this stake.

Open Veteran: Open only to hounds that are eligible to enter either Open or Special Stake, and are of Veteran age as determined by their Parent Breed Club. Championship or LCX points may be awarded from this stake.

Special: Open only to hounds that are eligible to enter the Open Stake and have earned their AKC Field Championship title. LCX points may be awarded from this stake. Hounds under disqualification from AKC, ASFA or CKC Field Trials may NOT be entered.

Singles: Open to all hounds of eligible breed, including those that are otherwise disqualified from entering the regular stakes (open, specials and veteran). Hounds entering in the singles stake may not also enter a regular stake at the same event. No championship or LCX points are awarded from this stake.

Best in Field (BIF) will be offered all days.

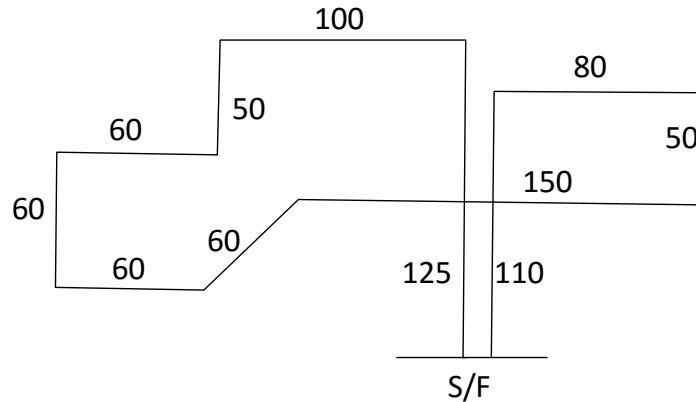

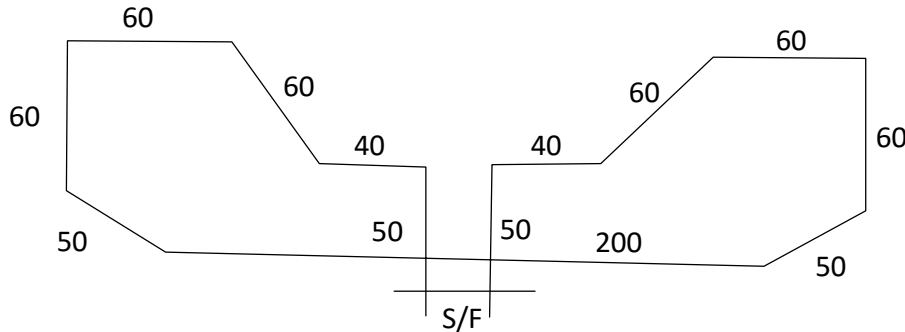
Course Plans
